<u>Medications:</u> All medications must be a prescription, all bottles place in a ziplock bag with your child's name on the bag and instructions inside. All medications must be updated before departure. They will be given to the camp nurse upon arrival.

<u>Rooming:</u> Some rooms may not have a chaperone and some may, but we are all very close together. Room assignments will not be determined until right before we leave depending on our boarding assignments.

- Lunches: We will be stopping for a fast food lunch on the way there and back. \$15-\$20 should be enough. Please put money in an envelope, marked with your child's name and "Lunches"
- Offering: They will be taking up an offering at camp. Put the offering you decide to give in a separate envelope labeled "Camp Offering" with your child's name. Check's should be made out to PDDC.
- 3. Snack Bar/CampMart: Open each evening, Gatorade(\$1.25), Corn Dog(\$1.00), Hot pretzel(\$1.00), Nachos(\$1.00), Pizza(\$2.00), Bottled Water (\$0.50). And the Gift Shop-Small souvenirs. Put this money in an envelope with your child's name marked "Extras".
- 4. Camp T Shirts are \$10 now and \$15 at camp.







Campers will be allowed three pieces of luggage: 1 suitcase (with toiletry bag inside), 1 backpack, and 1 bag for linens. Please put your child's name on the outside of these three bags so we can identify them easily. Also put your child's name on everything you can including bottles and linens. Your child will only have access to their backpack during the trip. All the suitcases and bags will be in storage and we will not go digging through them until we arrive at camp.
